Available to Alternative Entry Cohort students entering any full-time Cambrian College certificate or diploma program beginning in September. Applicants who have previously received a certificate or diploma or enrolled in a full-time program at Cambrian College will not be considered. Alternative Entry Cohort refers to any student who is entering Cambrian College but did not attend an Ontario high school in that same calendar year. This would include, but is not limited to: students who take time after graduation from high school to work, travel, or for personal reasons; students who attend university prior to attending Cambrian College; students who enter through the Cambrian College Access program; students who graduated from a high school outside of the province of Ontario; any international students entering Cambrian College in Sudbury, Ontario.
