 - Good academic standing (GPA of 3.0 or higher)
 - Contribution to College life
 - Demonstrated work in the community to promote Cambrian College and/or the Nominee's program of study.

- President's Silver Medal - \$1,500.00

1. Nominator Letter

- Provide a letter that comments on items such as:**
- Academic scholarships, awards, special recognition, and any other material that demonstrates academic excellence.
 - Participation in student governments, memberships in clubs and organizations, volunteer experience, leadership roles, sport activities, hobbies, artistic interests, etc.
 - How the Nominee has contributed to college life.

2. Faculty Letter

- Provide a letter that comments on items such as:**
- Demonstrated academic excellence by providing information on grades, any academic recognition received by the college President, Program Coordinator or other.
 - Class participation, leadership ability and peer tutoring.
 - The Nominee's overall contribution to his or her program.

3. Community Letter

- Provide a letter that comments on items such as:**
- The Nominee's work in the community to promote Cambrian College and/or the Nominee's program of study.

4. Nominee Letter

- Provide a personal letter from the nominee with information on:**
- His or her academic achievements and activities that demonstrate a contribution to college life.
 - Further comments on activities listed in the other three letters and if necessary, provide any new information.

Evaluation Structure

President's Gold Medal

- Academic achievement is weighed at 65%
- Activities demonstrating contribution to college life and work in the community to promote Cambrian College and/or the Nominee's program of study is weighed at 35%

President's Silver Medal

- Academic achievement is weighed at 50%
- Activities demonstrating contribution to college life and work in the community to promote Cambrian College and/or the Nominee's program of study is weighed at 50%
